NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, August 7, 2018, from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. for the purpose of nominating candidates to the following offices to appear on the November 2018 General Election ballot:

PARTISAN: Governor; United States Senator; Representative in Congress (10th District); State Senator (25th District); Representatives in State Legislature (32nd, 81st or 83rd District); St. Clair County Commissioners (Districts 1-7); and Delegates to the County Convention (delegates are elected in August and do not advance to November General).

PARTISAN (partial-terms): Clay Township Treasurer; East China Township Park Commissioners; Ira Township Supervisor and a Trustee; St. Clair Township Supervisor and a Trustee; Wales Township Supervisor and a Trustee.

NONPARTISAN: Marine City Commissioners.

All polling locations are accessible for voters with disabilities. Voting instructions will be available in audio format and in Braille. Arrangements for obtaining the instructions in these alternative formats can be made by contacting your local clerk in advance of the election.

ALL ELECTORS WHO WERE REGISTERED by July 9, 2018, are eligible to vote at this election. To see if you are registered, to find your polling location, to track an absentee ballot request or view a sample ballot, visit www.mi.gov/vote. Michigan election law provides that all voters will be asked to show photo identification before voting. Voters without identification will be required to fill out and sign an affidavit in order to receive a ballot.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS are available for all elections. Registered voters may contact their local clerk to obtain an application for an absent voter ballot or by visiting www.michigan.gov/vote to download the application. All requests must be in writing. The deadline for a local clerk to mail an absentee ballot to a voter is the Saturday preceding the election until 2:00 p.m. The deadline for in-person absentee voting is the Monday preceding the election until 4:00 p.m.
