Emergency Car Kit

Emergency Radio
Flashlight & extra batteries
Blankets or sleeping bags
Jumper cables
Bottled water
Nonperishable, high-energy foods
Compass & road maps
Hat & Gloves
Cat Litter (for traction)
Multi-Tool
Tow rope or chain
Glow Sticks
Plastic Bags (Sanitation)
First-aid Kit
Extra Medications
Expandable Shovel
Red Cloth (Tie to Antenna)



TIPS:

- Try to keep your gas tank near full at all times.
- Always carry emergency supplies including a flashlight, radio, shovel, extra warm clothing, bottled water, non-perishable foods, and a first-aid kit. Include a shovel and kitty litter for traction. If you have a cell phone, always bring it with you while driving.
- If you get stranded in your car, tie a red cloth around your antenna, make sure the exhaust pipe is not blocked, and run the motor for about 10 minutes each hour for heat.
