Violators of section 23a are subject to civil fines.

Plans are required for all building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, as amended and shall bear that architects or engineers signature and seal, except:

1. One and Two Family dwelling containing not more than 3,500 square feet of building area.
2. Alterations and repair work determined by the plumbing official to be of a minor nature.
3. Assembly, Business, Mercantile and Storage Buildings with a required Plumbing fixture count less than 12.
4. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00
5. Plans must be submitted before a Permit can be issued.

VI. Fee Clarifications

Of unit Sites, when setting a Manufactured Home in a park, or a mobile or modular home on private property, a permit should include the application fee, a Sewer or building Drain Item # 2, Mobile Home Unit Site: When item is used for sewer excavations in a new park, the Permit application should include the application fee plus the number and A water distribution pipe.

Water Closets, Sink (any), Slop Sink, Drinking Fountain, Floor Drain, Water Outlet or Connection, Water Tank, Bathtub, Emergency Eye Wash, Bidet, Condensate Drain, Roof Drain, Water Outlet, Connection to Heating System, Lavatories, Emergency-Shower, Cuspidor, Washing Machine, Grease Trap, Water Outlet, Connection to Filters, Shower Stall, Garbage Grinder, Dishwasher, Acid Waste Drain, Starch Trap, Connection to Sprinkler System (Irrigation), Laundry Tray, Water Outlet Cooler, Refrigerator, Embalming Table, Plastic Trap, Water Connected Sterilizer, Urinal, Ice Making Machine, Water Heater, Bed Pan Washer, Water Softener, Water Connected Dental Chair, Autopsy Water Connected Still, Water Connection to Carbonated Beverage Dispensers. ** Plus any other Fixture, Drain or Water Connected Appliance not Specifically Listed**

VIII. Lead Free Notice

The State Construction Code Act, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, requires pipes, pipe fittings, solder or flux, which are used in the installation or repair of a plumbing system in a building or structure, providing water for human consumption or a public water system, is lead free. A lead free is defined as solder or fluxes containing of more than 0.2%; and pipes and pipefitting containing not more than 8% lead. These provisions do not apply to leaded joints necessary for the repair of cast iron pipes.

IV. Instructions for completing Application

General: Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with the Charter Township of Port Huron Building installations shall be in conformance with the State Plumbing Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. When ready for an inspection, call the Township office providing 24 hours advance notice as possible. The inspector and Township office will need the job location and permit number.

Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commencing within Six Months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. A permit will be cancelled when No Inspections have been conducted within six months of the date of issuance or the date of a previous inspection. Cancelled Permits cannot be refunded or reinstated.
